This years Eastern High School Championship will be held March 7 -10, 2024 by Mount Washington Valley Ski Club at Attitash Mountain in New Hampshire. Thursday March 7th is a training day (GS and Slalom), Friday is Men and Women's Slalom, Saturday is Women's GS and Sunday Men's GS. The top six finishers (top 6 men/top 6 women) in the slalom and GS count towards the team score. Awards will also be given to those racers placing in the top six M/W finishers in GS and slalom.

TEAM CT will be represented by twelve men and twelve women from the CISL. CISL coaches can nominate a racer to compete for a spot on TEAM CT. We ask that coaches nominate racers that are finishing in the top 20 during the season. A link for nominations will be sent out to coaches next week. *Please do not nominate any racer who would not be available to compete that weekend.*

Nominees will compete in the GS Shoot Out on <u>Monday, February 5th</u> at 4:40 pm. The top 30 boys and top 30 girls will move on to compete in the Slalom Shoot Out Tuesday February 27th at 4:40 pm. Given the delay to the start of the season and the additional rescheduling or races due to weather issues, the dates noted above are the second and third rain dates for the events. This year the CISL will host 2 slalom training nights, Wednesday February 14th and Wednesday February 21st for those racers wishing to train before the 27th. <u>NOTE</u>: If regular season races are postponed further due to weather and interfere with the planned nights for Shoot Outs, we will have to just hold the Slalom shoot out and use the regular season rankings to guide the nominations.

The top 12 finishers for the boys and the girls will qualify for Team Connecticut and will compete at Easterns. Racers will need to hold a current USSS license to participate in the Eastern High School Championships. Racers may already hold a USSS Competition license if they regularly participate in USSS competitions. Other racers that qualify will need to purchase a 2023-2024 Non-Scored Athlete license for \$100.00.

We are looking forward to a wonderful season and a great time in New Hampshire.
