## 2026 Eastern High School Championships

This year's Eastern High School Championship will be held March 6 -9, 2026 by Franconia Valley Ski Club at Attitash Mountain in New Hampshire. Thursday, March 5th, is a training day (GS and Slalom). The *tentative* schedule is for Men and Women's Slalom on Friday, Women's GS Saturday, Men's GS Sunday, although the schedule *may change* based on conditions/weather. The top six finishers (top 6 men/top 6 women) in the slalom and GS count towards the team score. Awards will also be given to those racers placing in the top six M/W finishers in GS and slalom. TEAM CT will be represented by ten men and ten women from the CISL.

QUALIFIERS- Starting this year, an official leaderboard will be published on Tuesday featuring the top 25 finishers from both Class L and Class S races. Following the conclusion of the 3rd season's race, the racers participating in the first round of Team CT Qualifiers (GS Race) will be determined as follows:

- **Automatic Qualification:** The top 45 racers based on the season leaderboard will secure a seat for the first round.
- **Coach Nominations:** 5 additional seats remain open to be filled via coach nomination. These selections will be based specifically on racers' slalom points or past participation on Team CT. A link for nominations will be posted for coaches on the CISL website under the *Coach Tools* tab. We ask coaches not to nominate any racer who is not available to compete on the weekend of Easterns.

Named racers will compete in the GS Qualifiers on Monday, January 26th at 4:40 pm. The top 30 boys and top 30 girls will move on to compete in the Slalom Qualifiers on Tuesday, February 3rd at 4:40 pm.

NOTE: In order for a racer to compete in any qualifier, they must have a coach *or* parent present during the race.

The top 10 finishers for the boys and the girls qualify for Team Connecticut and will compete at Easterns. Racers will need to hold a current USSS license to participate in the Eastern High School Championships. Racers may already hold a USSS Competition license if they regularly participate in USSS competitions. Other racers that qualify will need to purchase a 2025-2026 Non-Scored Athlete license for \$100.00. Those who are 18 or older by the time of the championship will have to complete additional screenings through USSA.

We are looking forward to a wonderful season and a great time in New Hampshire.
